Algeria**

St. [Maximilian](#) was one of the first military draft resisters. In 295 he was executed for refusing military service. His fellow Christians considered Maximilian a model for all Christians and preserved a record of his trial.

On March 12<sup>th</sup>, 295, at Theveste in North Africa, which is present day Algeria the conscript Maximilian, with Victor his father, was brought into the court of Dion the Proconsul. Valerian Quintian, the imperial commissioner, was present.

The attorney for the treasury, Pomeianus, spoke first: “As Maximilian is liable for military service, I request that his height be measured.”

Dion, the proconsul, said to Maximilian, “What is your name?”

Maximilian: “Why do you want to know my name? I am not allowed to be a soldier. I am a Christian.”

Dion: “Measure him.”

When this was done, the assistant announced, “Five feet, ten inches,”

Dion: “Put the badge on him.”

Maximilian resisted commenting, “I refuse. I cannot serve.”

Dion: “Be a soldier. Otherwise, you must die.”

Maximilian: “I will not be a soldier. You can cut my head off, but I will not be a soldier of this world. I am a soldier of my God.”...

Dion: “I am going to send you to join your Christ, here and now.”

Maximilian: “Then do so quickly. It would be a great honor for me.”

Dion: “Become a soldier, and take the badge. If not, you will die a shameful death.”

Maximilian: “I shall not die. My name is already written down with my God. I cannot be a soldier.”

Dion: “Think of your youth and become a soldier. It is a fine life for a young man.”

Maximilian: “My service is to my God. I cannot be a soldier for this world. I have already told you. I am a Christian.”

Dion: “In the bodyguards of our lords, Diocletian and Maximian and Constantius and Maximus, there are Christian soldiers and they serve.”

Maximilian: “They know what they have to do. But I am a Christian and I cannot do what is evil.”

Dion: “But those who serve—what wrong do they do?”

Maximilian: “You know very well what they do.”

Dion: “Be a soldier. By refusing, you are inviting a cruel death.”

Maximilian: “But I will not cease to exist. If I leave the world, I shall live with Christ, my God.”

Dion: “Strike his name off.” When this was done, he said to Maximilian: “Since you have insubordinately refused to serve in the army, you shall suffer the penalty of the law. Let this be an example to others.” From a tablet, he then read out his sentence:

“Maximilian, out of insubordination, has refused the military oath, and is, therefore, condemned to die by the sword.”

Maximilian: “God be praised.”

He was twenty-one years old, three months and eighteen days.
